2007 Caliza Kissin' Cousins

Varietals: 44% Roussanne, 28% Grenache Blanc, 28% Viognier

Kissin' Cousins has lovely aromas and tastes of pear, stone fruits (such as peach and apricot) and hints of tropical fruits (such as pineapple and mango). This is a mouth filling wine that pleases from the moment it enters your mouth to the final swallow. The wine was fermented in 100% French oak barrels which provide a wonderful rich mouth feel and smooth "round" textures. A wonderfully rich and appealing wine!

Pink is a blend of Syrah and Grenache. The Syrah was fermented in stainless steel containers to keep the fruit flavors bright and fresh. The small amount of Grenache that was used in this Pink blend was fermented in American oak barrels which provides a mild and uniquely appealing undertone of spices such as clove and nutmeg.
